More Convenience!

Extended Service Hours and Days

Alamance County

• Increased weekday and midday service for express and circulator routes

Davidson County

- Increase service levels on US-52 and Business 85 Express
- Expand County Transportation System to include weekend service

Guilford County

Greensboro Transit Authority (GTA)

- More frequent bus service on connector routes (every 30 minutes)
- Add Sunday service on 12 routes

High Point Transit (Hi tran)

- Increase weekday service to 14 hours a day
- Increase Saturday service to 12 hours a day
- Add Sunday service on two routes

Piedmont Authority for Regional Transit (PART)

 15 minute headway (time between buses) on Greensboro and High Point routes


