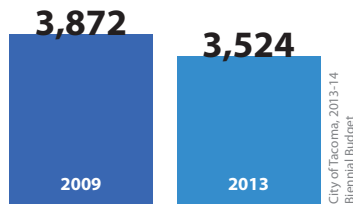

City employees



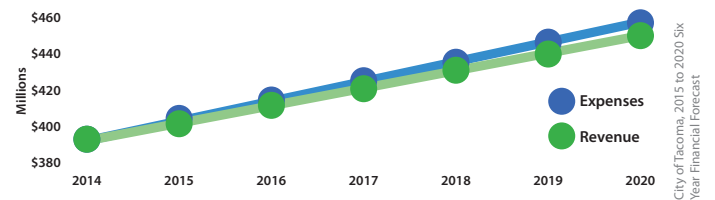
City government is 9% smaller today than it was four years ago.

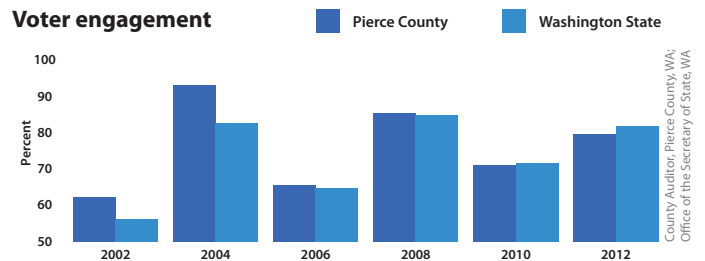
23 Committees, Boards, and Commissions advise City Council and City staff.
