
36 Line: Twin Springs Road Deviation



Light Rail Stations

Summary of Changes

Currently, the 36 Line operates a 1.2-mile deviation onto Twin Springs Lane off Washington Boulevard on every trip in order to serve the South Baltimore County Medical Center (a.k.a. Kaiser Permanente). The deviation has been in effect for over one year, with the majority of riders using the service between 5:30 am and 8:00 pm.

To improve the efficiency of the 36 line and to reduce the delay incurred by passengers who do not wish to access Kaiser Permanente, trips will now only operate the deviation between the hours of 5:40 am and 8:00 pm on weekdays and between 7:00 am and 8:00 pm on weekends. One exception to this plan will be that the last northbound and southbound weekday trips (which occur around 1:30 AM) will serve Kaiser to accommodate workers at the facility. In addition, when the deviation is in effect, only every other trip will operate the deviation. This will result in a 30-minute frequency during peak periods and a 60-minute frequency during the midday period.
